Archery GB cover only will apply – entry implies acceptance of these conditions • Anyone wishing to take photographs/video must complete the Photograph Log before doing so. • The Field Captain is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. His/her decision in all matters is final and must be obeyed. • The Tournament Organiser has the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour • For the comfort of all archers and spectators Tyndale Archers operates a 'No Smoking' policy, within the school grounds

This enables everyone to compete equally against one another.
